Refugees fleeing the communists were crammed into filthy barbed-wire camps in Thailand. The camps were bursting with the sick, the hungry, the dying, and the hopeless. Lois Callaway was an American missionary in Thailand at that time. Yoon Choy Saechao was a young village boy in Laos whose life was forever changed by the Silent War. It was in the stench of the Chiangkham refugee camp that their lives intersected, and Yoon Choy found salvation.

These two stories have become a singular story of crossing cultures and survival. The story is as much a tribute to Lois Callaway as to the Mien people like Yoon Choy, whom she loved and served. This book details many fascinating missionary experiences of Lois and C.W. Callaway and their 5 children from 1946 to 1998 in England, Burma, China, and the hilltribe villages and refugee camps of Thailand.
